Preliminary Admission Notice

(Academic Session 2021-22)

Considering the festive season and public requests, admissions for Class Playgroup (CBS Sonarpur) and Class Nursery (all four CBS Campuses) for the Academic Session 2021-2022 have been reopened. Parents seeking Admission of their wards into either of the above mentioned classes may please apply online from the school website (www.calcuttaboysschool.edu.in)

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- **Class Playgroup:** (CBS Sonarpur & CBS Asansol) Candidates for Playgroup should be 3 years and below 4 years of age as on 1st April 2021. Those candidates who do not fulfil this basic criteria will be disqualified.
- **Class Nursery:** (All four campuses of CBS) Candidates for Nursery should be 4 years and below 5 years of age as on 1st April 2021. Those candidates who do not fulfil this basic criteria will be disqualified.

ONLINE APPLICATION

The Admission Form will be available online in the website of Calcutta Boys' School on the dates specified on payment of Rs. 1000/- each. Admission Forms are also available from the School Office of the Asansol, Sonarpur and Beliaghata campuses only.

The Admission Form is **non-transferable**.

Kindly note that only **ONE** Admission Form will be issued online in the name of your ward **at ONLY ONE campus of Calcutta Boys' School of your choice.**

The Online Admission Link will be available on the respective campuses website from 6th November 2020.

The Admission Form must be filled in and uploaded online. Pursuant to the successful submission of the Admission Form, a user id and password (credentials) will be sent to the registered mobile number of the applicant. Log in on the web page of the respective branch, using the aforementioned credentials. **Print a copy of the admission form and deposit the same along with all the following enclosures in the collection box placed at the school gate of the respective campuses by the next day of the online submission.**

Enclosures:

The following **self-attested documents** must be submitted along with the admission form.

- a) Formal **family** photograph (**POST CARD SIZE**) of the Father, Mother and the candidate **ONLY**.
- b) **Self-attested** photocopy of the candidate's birth certificate from the Kolkata Municipal Corporation or equivalent body.
- c) **Self-attested** photocopy of the discharge certificate from the Institution where the child was born.
- e) **Self-attested** photocopy of the Immunization Certificate.
- f) **Self-attested** photocopy of the Baptism Certificate, duly attested by the Pastor-in-Charge (in the case of Christian candidates).
- g) **Self-attested** photocopy of SC/ST/OBC certificate (in case of SC/ST/OBC candidate).
- h) **Self-attested** photocopy of the ISC/ ICSE Certificate issued by the Council (in case of ex-students of the Calcutta Boys' School).
- i) **Self-attested** photocopy of Parents salary certificate or IT return form.

APPLICATION FORMS WITH INCOMPLETE INFORMATION / DOCUMENTS OR WHERE THE INSTRUCTIONS HAVE NOT BEEN ADHERED TO, WILL BE REJECTED.

CAUTION

1. Candidates who fall in Category A i.e. (a) Christians & Anglo-Indians (b) sons of CBS & CGHS Staff (c) sons of ex-students of CBS only and (d) those who have own brothers (**not 'cousin brothers'**) studying in Calcutta Boys' School are given preference. **However, selection for admission is not guaranteed for all.** They must fulfil all criteria, by the specified time and must fare well at the interaction.
2. Boys appearing for the Nursery Admission are not permitted private tuition from any staff member of this school. Discovery of any such arrangement will lead to disqualification of the candidate concerned.
3. No middle men will be entertained.
4. **The school does not accept any donations or other gifts in lieu of admissions.**
5. Any attempt to influence the decision of the Principal in the form of photocopies of application forms (directly or to any employee of the School or to any other person), gifts or letters of recommendation will adversely affect the child's chances of being selected for admission. Please remember that a deserving candidate will lose his chance for admission if any such attempt is made. Please help the school in the task of fair and unbiased selection.
6. A child is not admitted on the basis of merit or intelligence only. Our aim is to select a cross-section of all communities and classes.
7. **The Principal's decision is final and binding at all stages.**
